Special Session**

**On Saturday, April 5, 2014, at 6:00 PM, the Lumber River Conference of the Holiness Methodist Church met at the Conference Headquarters, Pembroke, NC.**

**Bishop James H. Woods was Presiding Bishop. Open song “Shall We Gather At The River”, was sung and prayer requests were given and prayer was lead by Rev. Marvin Locklear. Welcome was given by Bishop Woods and the roll was called. The following persons were unexcused absences at the meeting:**

***Old Business:***

**Letter of Affiliation with Lumber River Holiness Methodist Conference - (Rev. Oscar Henderson and Rev. Crites Oxendine) - Mt. Carmel Church/Rev. Henderson and Mission Church/Rev. Oxendine are not affiliated with our Conference but the ministers (Rev. Oscar Henderson and Rev. Crites Oxendine) are members of our Conference. After much discussion concerning whether or not these two (2) churches want to connect with our Conference, these two (2) ministers are to present this request to their church and report back at the August Special Session concerning this matter.**

***New Business:***

**(1) Quarterly Conference Changes – Everyone was given a copy of Rev. Elton Hunt’s proposal. After a discussion of these changes, the proposal is to go to the August Special Session for approval.**

- (2) Questions concerning the Doctrine and Discipline – Bro. Jerry Hunt had several questions concerning issues with the Doctrine and Discipline. His main concern was checks being pre-signed. Question was proposed as should there be only one person to sign the checks. Reference was made to the Doctrine and Discipline (Page 18) which states that all checks must be signed by the local Treasurer and a duly elected co-signer. It is the responsibility of the local Church’s Stewards to make sure that records are being kept in a proper manner.**
- (3) Doctrine and Discipline Books - Sis Dianne Belcher advised that new Doctrine and Discipline books that had been bound by a different method had been prepared and presented to the Church ministers for review. It was discussed that we would use all current books and then replace with new one when needed.**
- (4) Conference White Water Rafting Trip – Sis Debbie Chavis, Camping Coordinator, read a letter that she sent to all Church ministers, Sis. Kathy Oxendine, Conference Lay Leader, Bro. Crawley Locklear, Conference Supervisor and Sis. Dianne Belcher, Conference Secretary/Treasurer. This activity had not been approved by the Conference Bar and the Conference name was being used. After a lot of pros and cons discussion over this matter, a motion was made by Rev. Anthony Chavis to support or reject the White Water Rafting Trip in making this a Conference-Wide Support Function. A vote was taken (16 to 7) which gave approval of the trip. This is now an approved Conference function and will be added to the Activity Schedule beginning with the 2015 Conference year.**
